One of the most recognizable names in professional golf, Tom Lehman has five PGA Tour victories and four international wins to his credit including one major title, the 1996 Open Championship, in addition to recent titles on the Champions Tour. He was a three-time member of the prestigious U.S. Ryder Cup Team and captain of the team in 2006, as well as a three-time member of the Presidents Cup Team. He is the only golfer in history to have been awarded the Player of the Year honor on all three PGA Tours: the regular PGA Tour, the Web.com Tour and the Champions Tour. Outside of the professional golfing world, Lehman has truly set himself apart with his dedicated involvement in charitable organizations, including HopeKids where he serves as Honorary National Chairperson.

HopeKids works to restore hope to children who have been diagnosed with life-threatening medical conditions, bringing strength to their families and their communities through the message of hope as a powerful medicine. With local chapters in North Texas, Arizona, Colorado and Minnesota, HopeKids hosts highly-anticipated events for affected families in order to build a supportive, empowering and healing community.
